It's been more than 50 years since the first attempts were made to search for the existence of intelligent life beyond Earth. So far, nothing has been heard. What does this mean? Are we performing the right experiments? Are we asking the right questions?

In this presentation, Dr. Shostak, Senior Astronomer with the Search for Extraterrestrial Intelligence (SETI) Institute, will explain how modern technology is rapidly increasing the speed and extent of our search for alien life, and how new experiments could turn up a signal sooner than we think. Students will have a chance to interact with Dr. Shostak, an acclaimed scientist, author, television and radio host, asking questions and hearing the answer to that burning question - "Are Aliens Real?"
