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### Watch the Transit of Mercury with Your Students!

### Join us on Monday, May 9, at the TWISE Observatory from 6:00 a.m. onward to see the planet Mercury move slowly over the face of the Sun.

This rare celestial event only happens twelve times per century! Bring your students to view its slow transit across the disc of the sun with our solar filters and telescopes, which will be set up at our observatory from 6:00 a.m. onward. The transit will be visible from the early morning hours until 12:41 pm. A real world experience for your Grade 6 Sky Science unit!

The times of the event are as follows with the transit in progress before sunrise from our location:

- Sunrise - 5:43 a.m.
- Greatest Transit - 8:57 a.m.
