

## Welcome to Summer Camps at TELUS World of Science- Edmonton

Get ready to discover the wonders of science with us!

Here is what you need to know.

### What to bring to Camp:

- Lunch
  - Our camps are nut free, please be mindful of this when packing lunches and snacks
  - Please pack lunches that do not need to be warmed up, we do not have access to microwaves
  - We offer lunch for purchase from our Purple Pear Café. If you would like to purchase a lunch card for your camper, please contact our Bookings team at 780-451-3344.
- Water bottle
  - Please make sure water bottles are clearly labeled with child's name
- Clothing
  - Science can get messy, please wear clothing that can get science on them. You may want to pack a change of clothes.
  - All camps go outside, some more than others. Please make sure to have proper gear for the season, including sunscreen, a hat, and a sweater or raincoat for colder days.
  - All campers must wear closed toed shoes.
  - All campers must wear face masks while inside the science centre. Please ensure campers have more than one mask for the day

### What to know:

- Science Camps go from 9:00AM to 4:00PM. You will drop off and pick up campers from their camp room
- We offer Pre-Camp Care and Post-Camp Care for a fee.
  - Pre-Camp Care begins 7:30AM and Post-Camp Care goes until 5:30PM. If you have purchased Pre/Post Camp Care, then please head to the Camp Care Room for drop off and pick up.
  - If you would like to purchase Pre-Camp Care and/or Post-Camp Care please contact our Bookings team at 780-451-3344.
- **Camp Cancellation Policy:** An administrative fee of \$15.00 will be assessed on all refunds/camp transfers. Refunds will be granted upon email request 21 days prior to the first of registered camp. No refunds/camp transfers will be issued with less than 21 days' notice prior to camp start.

### Behavioral Expectations:

- We expect all campers to demonstrate kindness and respect to themselves, other people, and property at all times.
- Campers who are disrespectful or harmful will be given a warning and encouraged to improve their behavior. If the disrespectful behavior persists, families will be contacted, and the camper may be asked to leave camp.
