This individual will inspire all guests by initiating conversations and other presentation formats including talks, demonstrations, hands-on science opportunities, and exhibit interpretation. This individual must approach their work with a feeling of excitement, curiosity, and wonder.

The Science Presenter reports to Director, Science Experiences with primary supervision by assigned Staff Scientists.

- Strong public speaking or presenting skills with the desire to share, collaborate, create, and experiment with all ages and audiences.

- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills, and the ability to work both independently and as part of a team.
- Deep discipline-specific knowledge related to the positions. Example: Health Zone needs biology, human physiology, and anatomy experience with a good understanding of proper laboratory practices. Science Garage needs Engineering, Computer Coding, or "tinkering" experience.
- Ability to provide positive leadership and mentorship for a dynamic and diverse team.

- Degree/certificate in Education, Science, Science Communication or similar field (Biology, Kinesiology, Engineering) is preferred. Combination of other education and experience will be considered.
