The Art of the Brick, The World's Largest Display of LEGO® Art, Coming to TELUS World of Science – Edmonton

EDMONTON, AB – January 27, 2023 – Starting May 5, *The Art of the Brick,* the world's largest display of LEGO art, opens at TELUS World of Science – Edmonton. The captivating exhibition, made up of millions of LEGO bricks, features over 100 incredible works of art by artist Nathan Sawaya.

While using LEGO bricks as the sole art medium, Sawaya's ability to conceptualize action, with his devotion to spatial perfection, allows him to elevate a beloved toy into contemporary art.

"The Art of the Brick takes LEGO somewhere you wouldn't expect, & shows you things you have never seen before," said artist Sawaya. "The goal with this collection of art is to demonstrate the potential of imagination & the power of creativity."
