



A few days before camp starts, my adult will receive an email from my camp leader. We can read the email together to learn who my camp leader is, what activities we will do, what time to come, and more.






Before my first day of camp, I make sure I have clothes and shoes to play in, a lunch, a snack, and my backpack.



On the first morning of camp, I will go to the Science Centre and check in at the camp rooms.






We will follow the signs because the camp rooms are far away. We can play a game to find the signs!






If we get lost, we can ask a worker for directions. The workers all wear purple. If I need help, or have a question, I will find one of them.



When we get to the camp rooms, I will meet my camp leader. My caregiver will check me in for the day.





My camp leader will have a wristband for me to wear. It might feel weird, but I can ask for it to be looser!

It has important information that helps adults return me to my camp leader. I will show a worker my wristband if I get lost.





When I feel ready and safe, I will say "goodbye" to my caregiver. I'll see them when camp is over later today.



I will put my backpack and coat on the rack at the back of the classroom. This is where I can keep my stuff while at camp.



For the first 15-20 minutes, I can play with toys while the leader checks all the campers in. I will remember to share with other kids.




I will meet the other kids in my camp. I can introduce myself and say "Hi!" if I want to.



My camp leader will tell us the rules and take us on a tour of the Science Centre. I will remember the rules: to stay safe and have fun!



We will do activities like crafts, builds, experiments, and challenges. For example, we might make slingshots!



Some activities I will do by myself, some I will do with partners. I can always ask my leader if I need help or am confused!





On some days, we will go watch movies in the IMAX® Theatre or the Zeidler Dome theatre. Sometimes, there are loud noises and bright lights in the movies.



We will explore different galleries in the Science Centre. Some galleries are loud, and I can ask my leader for headphones.



We will eat lunch in a classroom. It might be the classroom I have my camp in, but I might move to a different one. If I am curious, I can ask my camp leader which room we eat in.





After we eat, we will play outside, as long as the weather is nice.



After lunch we have more time to do experiments and explore the galleries. It's different every day!



Sometimes the leader will change activities if there isn't time to do them all. If I really want to do an activity, I can ask the leader if we can do it tomorrow.



Camp ends at 3:30 p.m., but my adult might pick me up later. I have free time to play in the classroom with my new friends. I may be asked to pack my backpack, so I am ready when my adult comes.





I will wait in the camp room for my adult to pick me up. I may stay longer than other campers in post-care. My camp leader will tell me when they get here!



I will gather my stuff and remember to take all my crafts home. I can tell my adult all about my fun day at science camp!
