Giant-sized adventure hits IMAX September 27 at TELUS World of Science – Edmonton

EDMONTON, AB — September 18, 2025 — TELUS World of Science — Edmonton is excited to announce the premiere of *Elephants: Giants of the Desert* in IMAX® 3D, opening Friday, September 27. This larger-than-life documentary takes Science Centre guests on an unforgettable journey into the Namib Desert, one of the harshest environments on Earth, to experience the extraordinary survival story of desert elephants. With stunning aerial footage and immersive sound, it delivers both a cinematic spectacle and a rare look into the delicate balance of life in one of Earth's oldest deserts.

"We're excited to bring Edmonton audiences this rare opportunity to travel to the heart of Africa's Namib Desert and come face-to-trunk with desert elephants," said Constance Scarlett, President & CEO of TELUS World of Science – Edmonton. "The film brings together breathtaking cinematography and compelling science, highlighting how these animals adapt to extreme conditions and what that means for our understanding of resilience in nature."

The film follows Little Foot, a newborn calf, as she navigates her first year of life in the desert with the guidance of her mother and protective herd. Viewers will witness the strength of the family herd, the wisdom of the matriarch, and the powerful instinct to survive that allows them to find hidden water sources, endure sandstorms, and thrive in a seemingly uninhabitable landscape.

With fewer than 150 desert elephants remaining in Namibia today, compared to thousands in centuries past, the film also emphasizes the importance of ongoing conservation efforts. Scientists believe studying these elephants' unique adaptations provides critical insights into both species' survival and broader ecosystem health in arid regions.

Oscar and Emmy nominated actress Naomi Watts narrates *Elephants: Giants of the Desert*, which was made for IMAX and filmed in native 3D.
