

Laser Mania lights up TELUS World of Science – Edmonton this fall

EDMONTON, AB — October 1, 2025 — TELUS World of Science – Edmonton is excited to announce *Laser Mania 2025*, an electrifying series of shows in the Zeidler Dome that pair legendary music with cutting-edge laser technology. The *Laser Mania* lineup on select Friday and Saturday nights includes *Laser Queen* until October 11, *Laser Country* until November 8, and the rock-powered *Laser Ozzfest Assault* October 17 – November 8, 2025.

“Laser shows are a full sensory spectacle. We blend laser imagery, animation, and abstract visuals in RGB format with full-dome effects like star fields, fractals, and tunnels, all synchronized to the music of the artists being showcased. It’s the only show of its kind in Alberta, and you really must see it in person to experience how it tantalizes the senses,” said Frank Florian, Senior Manager, Planetarium & Space Science at TELUS World of Science – Edmonton.

Laser Queen celebrates the Rock & Roll Hall of Famers with iconic hits like *We Will Rock You*, *Somebody to Love*, *Bohemian Rhapsody*, and *We Are the Champions* paired with dazzling laser choreography. The all-new *Laser Country* showcases Alberta’s love of country music with favourites from Garth Brooks, Shania Twain, Brooks & Dunn, Faith Hill, and more. For those who like it louder, *Laser Ozzfest Assault* brings the raw energy of Ozzy Osbourne, Black Sabbath, and Ozzfest’s greatest bands, featuring tracks like *Crazy Train*, *Paranoid*, and *Toxicity*. With powerful lasers, surround sound, and playlists packed with fan favourites, the series delivers an experience audiences have never seen — or heard — before.

Laser shows at the Science Centre harness all the advanced capabilities of the Zeidler Dome. Five powerful laser projectors illuminate the Dome with vibrant beams of light, while twelve 4K projectors fill the skies with kaleidoscopic backgrounds. A 17.2 surround sound system completes the show, pumping out fan-favourite tracks and immersing audiences in a symphony of light and sound.

Laser shows have something for everyone. Whether audiences remember experiencing *Laser Floyd* in the 1980s or are following today’s biggest hitmakers, the evolving lineup appeals to every age group and taste in music. From the legendary sounds of Pink Floyd and Queen to modern icons like Taylor Swift, no two shows are ever the same. *Laser Stranger Things* (November 15 – December 6), *Laser Zeppelin* (December 12 & January 2), *Laser Taylor Swift* (November 15 – January 3) and *Laser Floyd* (December 13 – January 3) are coming up after *Laser Mania 2025*.
